

One form, and every household in your community is covered.

HOW A GROUP ROLLOUT WORKS

1 Send one member list.

Mobile numbers and/or emails, with your attestation that members have agreed. That attestation is kept on record — consent is logged per person, permanently.

2 Everyone is enabled the same week.

Members do nothing. You introduce the number; the service simply answers when someone forwards something. Add or remove people any time with a one-line email.

3 One monthly invoice — or none.

Billed to the group, or each family pays their own. Both work. Simple per-member pricing; we'll quote your community's size the same day.

We never message anyone first. Ever.

The only thing a member ever receives is a reply to something they sent us — a rule they can check for themselves from day one. Anyone can stop the messages any time by replying STOP.

WHAT A MEMBER EXPERIENCES

● Looks fine

"That's a genuine Australia Post link. Nothing to do."

● Be careful

"We can't confirm this sender. Don't tap the link — go to the app instead."

● This is a scam

"SCAM — that's not your bank. Don't reply. Here's what to do instead."

Australians reported \$2.18 billion lost to scams in 2025, and people over 65 carry losses far beyond their share of the population (National Anti-Scam Centre, Targeting Scams 2025). The strongest protection is the simplest: a trusted place to ask before acting.

We also run a free 30-minute scam talk for community groups — plain English, this month's real examples, and a live check from a volunteer's phone. No selling from the front of the room.
